COMMUNITY COURSE FACILITATOR

Do you have a heart to see women thrive? Imago Dei Prison Ministry is a Christian charity working with women in touch with the Criminal Justice System. Part of our ministry is providing #SheMatters Courses in Gillingham, Maidstone and Ashford.

We are looking for volunteer female Course Facilitators to present our courses. No previous experience of course facilitation is necessary but would be useful. Confidence in presentation skills is essential and full training will be given.

You must be free in the day time and be able to start by 9am if it's a morning course or finish after 3pm if it's an afternoon course. Travel costs will be paid. DBS checks and references will be needed.

FUNDRAISER ASSISTANT

We are looking for an individual to help assist our fundraiser. Your role will be varied, helping with different tasks to raise funds and increase the profile of Imago Dei. Our shop is located in Tunbridge Wells town centre, with very good transport links. You will receive full induction and training. DBS checks and references needed.

VOLUNTEER WITH ID ESSENCE

ID Essence are passionate about supporting young women to realise their worth and power for change. We are the young adults project of Imago Dei (ID) Prison Ministry, working with young women in prison and the community to help grow their self-belief, equip them with necessary life skills, and support them to change their lives for the better.

Are you interested in joining us?

CHAPLAINCY

Assist ID Essence staff and/or ID Prison Ministry in their chaplaincy work in prison; help to build relationships with women, either through helping with chaplaincy groups and worship nights or attending and assisting with Sunday chapel services.

ADMINISTRATIVE

Assist in fundraising and administrative work of ID Essence. Assist with fundraising efforts when needed and campaigns, assisting in preparation of materials for various courses, assist with our social media and website content and any other administrative tasks that come up.

COMMUNITY

Assist in the delivery of resettlement work. Assist with community delivery of support services, and support the ID Essence community team in building and maintaining relationships with women after their release from prison, helping build a network with other community agencies.

EDUCATION

Help to facilitate educational myLife courses. Help to create a positive learning environment and build relationships with those taking courses. This can be in either a group or one-to-one context.

Volunteers wanting to volunteer in the prison must be able to commit to volunteering for a minimum of 12 months after their clearance has come through
*ID Essence is a faith based Christian project and our work in the prison is based with the chaplaincy department, because of this some of the roles require that volunteers and staff members have a Christian faith of some kind, but not all of the roles - if you have any questions about this please do ask.

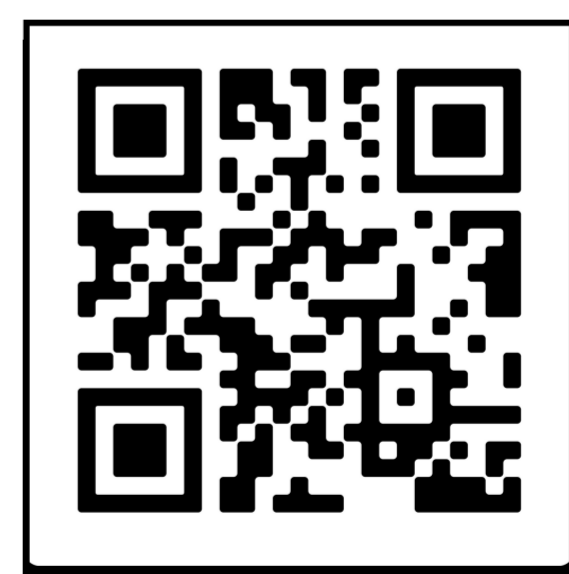
